

4.4.2 Use of Board Facilities

The Tuscaloosa City Board of Education allows the use of school buildings and grounds by the community for educational, recreational, civic and ancillary activities to the extent possible under the law.

When space is available at times that do not interfere with Tuscaloosa City Schools' instructional programs, student activity programs, or ancillary programs sponsored, administered, or supported by TCS, including its Parent Teacher Associations, members of the public may reserve school facilities in accordance with the administrative procedures set forth in the Facilities Use Manual as approved by the TCS Board of Education.

Applications for use of facilities for any activity deemed by the Superintendent or designee to be an unreasonable safety risk will be denied. Requests for personal social activities, partisan political activities, weddings, or funerals will be denied.

ANY PERMITTED USE OF THE FACILITIES IS SUBJECT TO CANCELLATION SHOULD THE FACILITY BE NEEDED FOR TCS INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS OR STUDENT ACTIVITY PROGRAMS.
