Requirements and Meetings

- All Eastwood Middle School students are invited to apply for representative positions. All who wish to participate must complete the application for membership and return it to Mrs. Craig by April 5, 2021.
- Every applicant and member of the SGA must have at least an 80 average in all core subject areas and be in good standing with the administration. Students are deemed ineligible if they have an expulsion, out of school suspension, or in school suspension for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Meetings will be held after school on the first Thursday of each month.
